

Scout Bingo Instructions: Great get to know you game

Print off the Scout Bingo sheet; one sheet per girl. Let each girl fill in the squares with things about her or ask the girls questions and let them put their answer in any square. Each girl goes around and finds out which girls match her answers for example red hair, blue eyes, 1 sister and so forth. Then see who gets Bingo first or Blackout. The girls will enjoy this.

Variation: Use this game for #4 requirement of Caring and Sharing – Differences are OK. Talk to the girls about what they found out about each other. Write the questions down on a board and ask the girls as a group to answer the questions. Point out to the girls how they are the same and different. For example the girls with blonde hair are the same, but each one is cut differently. They are all girls and they are all scouts but some may be in different age groups. They all go to school but different ones.

Example Questions

What is your favorite color?
What is your favorite food?
What is your favorite music?
What is your favorite movie?
Do you have any brothers? How many?
Do you have any sisters? How many?
Are you an only child?
Are you the oldest child?
Are you the youngest child?
What color are your eyes?
What color is your hair?
What is your favorite class in school?
What is the first letter of your name?
What school do you attend?
What length is your hair?
What is your favorite holiday?
What is your favorite TV show?
Do you have a pet?
Do you have a dog? How many?
Do you have a cat? How many?
How many years have you been in scouts?
What month is your birthday?
What year were you born?
